

# Beach Hut Cushion



## Requirements

Janome Sewing Machine (*DC6050 used for project*)

Zig Zag Foot **A**

Satin Stitch Foot **F**

Janome #12 sharp needle

Janome plastic bobbins

Thread snips / scissor

Dressmaking pins

Sewing thread

Toy stuffing

Fabric (see page 3 for cutting instructions)

Fat quarters for front, roof and back.

Red felt for door.

## Step 1

Place the roof on the front fabric, right-sides together and pin.



## Step 2

Use zig zag foot **A**. Select straight stitch.

Line-up foot with fabric edge and stitch seam.



## Step 3

Position the door on the front, make there is a gap of 1.5cm between the door and the lower edge of the hut front, then pin in place.



## Step 4

Attach satin stitch foot **F** to the machine.

Select the applique blanket stitch.

Stitch around the edges of the door.

*Tip: When stitching, the needle is positioned off the felt door edge on the main fabric, the stitch movement to the left will stitch onto the red felt door attaching the door to the main fabric.*



## Step 5

Use a single decorative stitch as the door handle.

## Step 6

Place the backing fabric piece on top of the front section, right-sides together. Then, pin.



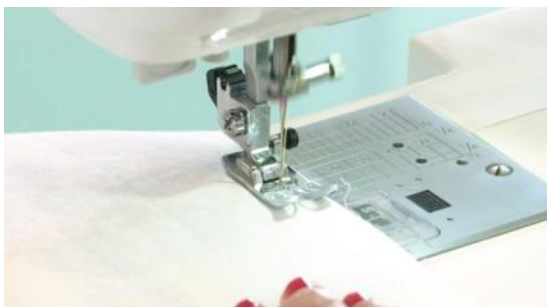

## Step 7

Attach zig zag foot **A**. Select straight stitch. Line-up foot with fabric edge and stitch around the edge, leaving a 10cm opening, to turn through.

*Tip: Start stitching seam from the bottom of the hut.*



## Step 8

Turn through to the right side. Stuff with toy stuffing.



## Step 9

Pin closed the 10cm opening. You can hand-stitch closed or use machine, stitching close to the fabric edge, making sure you catch both top and bottom fabric pieces.
