

# Cat Stuffy

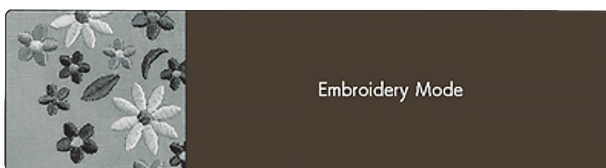
## Requirements...

- Cotton Terry Toweling Material  
(Backed with Fusible Interfacing Weft)
- Medium Weight Tear Away Stabilizer
- Water Soluble Stabilizer
- Toy Fill
- Embroidery Threads
- Janome Bobbin  
(Filled with BobbinFil)
- Hand Sewing Needle and Thread
- Blue Tip Needle
- RE46d hoop and hoop magnetic clips



## Instructions...

1. Select Embroidery Mode.



2. Select the Design Category Key.



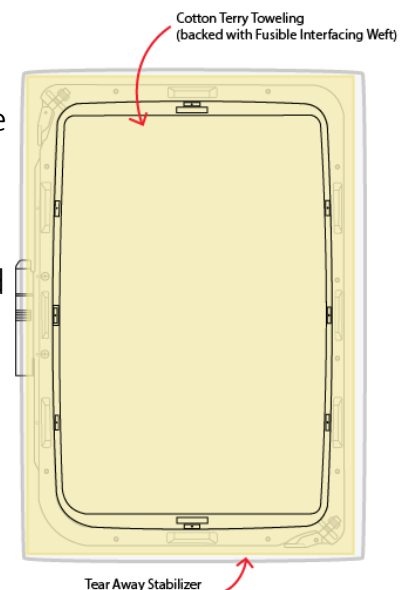
3. Using the Next Page Key, scroll through to #21.



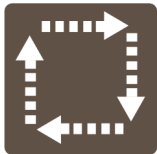
4. Select Design #5.



5. Hoop a single layer of Tear Away Stabilizer and the Cotton Terry Toweling .



6. Using the basting stitch, basting a single layer of Water Soluble Stabilizer to the top of the hooped fabric.



7. Stitch out the colour changes, stopping after colour change 5 is completed.
8. Place the second piece of interfaced cotton terry toweling right side down over the top of the hoop and stitch out the final colour change.



9. After the stitching is finished, remove the fabric from the embroidery hoop.
10. Remove the stabilizer from the back of the design.

11. Cut the fabrics along the cut-offline. (The outer stitch line of the design)



12. Cut slits from the edge of the fabric to 2mm in front of the seam in the curved areas (Be careful not to cut the seams).



13. Turn the cat out from the opening on the side.

14. Remove the excess stabilizer from the front of the design.

15. Stuff the cat with toy fill.

16. Hand stitch the opening closed.
