Snowman Placemat



Requirements...

- Bamboo Wadding (20"w X 15" h)
- Black Homespun -

Block A (17"w X 18"h)

Block B (20" w X 15" h)

Panel A (2½"w X 14 ½"h)

- Decorative Fabric 3 x (2½"w X 14 ½"h)
- Embroidery Thread (Contrasting to the Homespun)
- Blue Tip Needle
- Janome Bobbin (filled with BobbinFil)
- Medium Weight Tear Away Stabilizer
- Pins
- Basting Spray



This makes one placemat

- Sewing Thread (to match Homespun)
- Bias Binding
- SQ23d Hoop
- Bobbin filled with Sewing thread

Instructions...

1. Select Embroidery Mode.



2. Select the Design Category Key.



3. Select Seasons and Special Designs (Christmas).




4. Select Design



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 Hoop a single layer of tear away stabilizer and the black Homespun (Block A), in the SQ23d Hoop.





6. Following machine instructions stitch out the design.



- 7. Remove hoop when completed . Remove stabilizer and press with an iron. Trim down to a 13% " (w) X 14% " (h) block.
- Attach the Dual Feed Quilt Piecing Foot (OD).



9. Engage the Dual Feed Key.



10. Select Sewing Applications Mode.



11. SelectQuiltingMenu.



12. Select Patchwork Piecing option.



13. Select the Straight Stitch option.






14. On the left side of the embroidered block, pin a panel of decorative fabric (right sides together). Stitch the two



pieces of fabric together.

When you complete the stitch a message will appear on the screen. Press the OK and the machine will memorize that seam length.





15. Repeat so there is a panel on decorative fabric attached to both sides of the embroidered block.

After sewing the memorized length, a message will appear on the screen. To sew the same length, start stitching and it will stop automatically after completing the memorized stitch length.



16. When completed, open out the decorative panels and press with an iron.



- 17. On the right side of the decorative fabric panel, pin black Homespun (Panel A) right sides together, stitch using the 1/4inch seam. Open out and press with an iron.
- 19. Attach the third panel of decorative fabric to the open edge of the back homespun panel.

When stitching is completed, press X on the screen to reset the memorized stitch length.




20. Create a quilt sandwich with the embroidery piece on top, Bamboo Wadding in the centre and Black homespun (Block B) on the bottom.





21. Use basting spray and quilting pin to hold the layers together.



22. Attach the Dual Feed Ditch Quilting



23. Reset the Stitch back to
Utilities Stitch 3 and adjust the length to 3mm.



24. Stitch in the ditch between the black and decorative fabric panels. Trim away any excess fabric.



25. Attach black Bias Binding to the raw edges of the placemat.
